## Call for Mock-ups

Copenhagen symposium: 14-16 June

### *mock-up (also mockup)*

*noun*

- a model or replica of a machine or structure, used for instructional or experimental purposes;

- an arrangement of text and pictures to be printed.

## Mock-up

Taking on the experiences made during the last four *BER-LON-CPH* symposiums, the Copenhagen seminar borrows the figure of the *mock-up* as a way to investigate and test the possibility of bringing together different aspects of our research through experimental forms. By applying the idea of the mock-up to the academic work, the aim is to enable new and different formats, models, tools, and media to take shape within the frame of a 1:1 testing. We want to benefit from the rich semantics of mocking and ask what happens when we envisage our dissertation through different formats:

How do you imagine your Ph.D. project through text, visuals, audio-visual media, performance or whatever formats you can think of? How does content and form correlate and how do they influence each other and create new meaning? How can different formats help disseminate the results of your research?

### Instructions for use:

1. Draw a sketch or write an abstract of your imagined PhD dissertation, which can include text, sound, images, or whatever medial form suits your PhD topic (aprox. 300 words, images, drawings, video, sound etc).

The sketch should be submitted to [mockupdissertation@gmail.com](mailto:mockupdissertation@gmail.com) **no later than April 30th**

2. Based on the sketch create a mock-up of your project: it can be a part of an article, a chapter, or your research in an embryonic form. The content of the mock-up depends on your topic and on the content of your research: *let the content guide or determine the form*. The mock-up should be structured into a 10-15 min presentation to be delivered at the symposium, where it will be collectively discussed, transformed, developed, and enacted.
